

# Searching for Institutions

## ① Enter Keywords

As you type, keyword suggestions will automatically appear.

- **Multiple Keywords:** Separate words with a space to find items that contain **any** of your keywords (an OR search).
- **Exact Phrases:** Enclose a specific phrase in double quotes to find an exact match (e.g., "intangible cultural heritage").

## ② Filter Your Results

Use the filter to narrow your search by a specific attribute.

- **Country:** Filter results by the country where the facility is located.

## ③ Use the Advanced Search

- For more specific searches, add new fields and set your conditions as needed. You can search by: **Name in original language**, **Type**, **Country**, and **Tel**.

## ④ Get Your Results

Click the **Search** button to view the results based on your keywords and filters.

## ⑤ Use the Interactive Map

Find institutions directly on the map.

- **Numbered circles** show the total number of institutions in an area.
- **Click a circle** or use your scroll wheel to zoom in for a closer look.
- As you zoom, individual **location icons** will appear.
- **Click any icon** to see that institution's details.
