### Who can apply:

**Early career researchers (no age limit)** who are working on or have conducted research on intangible cultural heritage (ICH) in the Asia-Pacific Region and have little or no experience of publishing a research paper, such as:

- ✓ Graduate students and postdoctoral researchers
- ✓ Researchers having recently started working on ICH-related topics
- ✓ Researchers working for NGOs, government agencies, museums, etc.
- ✓ ICH practitioners who have been involved in research

Interested applicants should complete and submit the [online application form](#), which includes:

- ✓ 500-word summary of your research topic, approach and methodology
- ✓ Brief statement of approximately 500 words, summarizing your research background and why you would like to participate in the programme

After screening of all submitted documents, selected applicants will be invited for an online interview.

**Accepted applicants will be notified by the end of August 2024.**
